#### Restraints:

DO NOT USE on sheep which are producing or may in the future produce Milk that may be used or processed for human consumption.

DO NOT USE on sheep with less than 6 weeks wool.

This product is designed for use on sheep with at least 6 weeks wool growth (long wool).

#### Mixing: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Settling may occur after storage for some weeks. Stir product or invert container several times before opening. Pour the liquid into the vat through a strainer to remove any dry particles or flakes which can occasionally occur under hot storage conditions. Stir well. This product is readily dispersible in both soft and hard water.

#### Maintenance of Dips

1. Clean out dip, sump and spray lines thoroughly before charging. Disinfect with a registered bacteriostat at the manufacturer's recommended rate.
2. DO NOT USE old fouled wash. Shower dips should be emptied and cleaned out at the end of each day's dipping. Plunge dips should be emptied and cleaned out within 5 days of charging and more frequently if conditions favour post-dipping lameness infection, except in WA where plunge dips and sumps should be emptied daily.

#### Dilution Rate

Dilution rate: 2mL per 1 Litre water  
 Examples: 400mL per 200 Litres  
 2L per 1000 Litres

3. Before use, stir well.

**Jetting:** Jet the sheep at onset of fly wave with efficient equipment which is able to maintain the pressure of about 550 kPa. Use 300 to 400 kPa for lambs and ewes in lamb.

**Bacteriostat:** This product does not contain a bacteriostat. For control of post-dipping infections a registered bacteriostat should be added at the manufacturer's recommended rate.

#### SAFETY DIRECTIONS

May irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When opening the container and preparing the dip or jetting fluid, wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist, a washable hat and elbow length PVC gloves, face shield and water resistant footwear. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each day's use, wash gloves, face shield and contaminated clothing.

**Sheep Rehhandling interval:** After treatment wait until sheep are dry before rehhandling.
