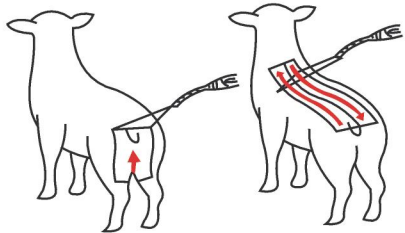

Apply ProGuard Spray-On according to the diagram and tables in the Directions for Use. ProGuard Spray-On may be applied to all breeds of sheep, providing protection against fly strike. ProGuard Spray-On is applied as a low-volume treatment onto or near the area where protection is required. When applying, the nozzle of the applicator gun should be approximately 25 cm above the fleece, to achieve a 15cm wide band at each pass.
