Restraint:

DO NOT USE on cattle which are producing or may in the future produce milk for human consumption.
This product is contraindicated for use on pregnant cows within 6 weeks of calving to avoid handling stress.

WITHOLDING PERIODS:

Tick infested cattle introduced onto properties where a TIK BOS treatment regime is in place should be treated with TIK BOS prior to release.

Cleaning Instructions
